Join the **M6** motorway and continue to the **M42** motorway

At Junction **3a** of the **M42** join the **M40**

Leave **M40** at junction **15** (signposted **London**)

Take **5th** exit at **Longbridge roundabout** onto **A46** (signposted **Stratford**)

Follow **A46** for approx **6.5 miles** and then at roundabout take **1st exit** onto the **A4300** (signposted **Stratford**)

At **roundabout** take **1st exit** onto **A3400** (signposted **Through Traffic**)

At **Traffic Signals** turn **right** onto **A4390** (signposted **Bidford**)

At **Traffic Signals** continue forward (signposted **Bidford**)

At **roundabout** take **2nd exit** onto Evesham Road B439 (signposted **Bidford**)

Turn **left** onto **Luddington Road**

Finish on **Luddington Road**.

Total Miles approx 115 Approx Time 2 hours
